1	ZIP_CODE	NCHAR(5)	The ZIP Code of the city designated by the USPS.
2	STATE	CHAR(2)	The two-letter abbreviation for the state to that particular ZIP code.

1. ZIP_CODE

A five-digit code (00000-999999) which identifies a specific geographic delivery area. ZIP also known as “Zone Improvement Plan”. ZIP Codes represent an area within a state or a single building or company with high mail volume. In very rare case, a ZIP Code shares different states boundaries.

2. STATE

The 2-letter abbreviation represents the name of the state or US Territory. For example, AZ stands for Arizona and CA stands for California.
